

PUBLIC NOTICE

THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MILTON KEYNES (VARIOUS ROADS OR PARTS OF REDWAY IN FISHERMEAD, WESTON UNDERWOOD, WALNUT TREE AND WOLVERTON) (TEMPORARY CLOSURES) ORDER 2016

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Borough of Milton Keynes intends, in not less than seven days from the date of this Notice, to make the above Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit vehicles and pedestrians from entering, waiting or proceeding along the following lengths of road in order to allow maintenance and repair works to be carried out on the highway:

The following length of road will be provisionally closed on 21st December 2016 (for a maximum period of 4 hours) in order for Milton Keynes Council to carry out highway maintenance:-

- **Cross Lane, Weston Underwood** – Its entire length
Whilst the above length of road is closed there will be no alternative route.
- **Cambridge Street, Wolverton** – From its junction with Stratford Road to its junction with Church Street.
Whilst the above length of road is closed the alternative route will be via Stratford Road, Radcliffe Street and Church Street (and vice versa).

The following lengths of road will be provisionally closed on 22nd December 2016 (for a maximum period of 4 hours on each day) in order for Milton Keynes Council to carry out highway maintenance:-

- **Gurnards Avenue, Fishermead** – From its junction with Pentewan Gate to its junction with Pencarrow Place.
Whilst the above length of road is closed the alternative route will be via Pentewan Gate, Penryn Avenue and Pencarrow Place (and vice versa).
- **Redway that links Dunchurch Dale and Lichfield Down, Walnut Tree** – Its entire length
Whilst the above length of redway is closed the alternative route will be via the redways on Lichfield Down and Dunchurch Dale (and vice versa).

Access to businesses and residential properties will be maintained throughout the closures.

The above closures are scheduled to be provisionally implemented on the above dates for a maximum period of 4 hours or until the said works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. Signs will be erected several days in advance to warn motorists and pedestrians of the dates and times when the roads will be closed.

The Council is satisfied that the temporary closure Order is necessary to enable works to be carried out on the highway. The temporary Order will come into effect on 21st December 2016 and will expire on 21st March 2017 and will take effect at times during the above period **only** when maintenance or repair works are required and **only** when indicated by the appropriate traffic signs, which will be erected in advance of any closure.

There will be no exemptions from the provisions of the proposed Order except for controlled access to business or residential properties and emergency service vehicles on operational duties.

All affected properties will be notified of the forthcoming closures at least one week prior to works taking place. Any person committing a breach of the order will be liable upon prosecution to such fine as is prescribed by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
