

SCHEME OF DELEGATED AUTHORITY

Details of decisions taken under the Council’s adopted scheme of delegated authority during September 2021. Note that up until 7 July 2021, the adopted scheme gave delegated authority to make decisions to the Council Manager, in consultation with the Chair and Vice-Chairs of relevant Committees (or in the case of policy, the Chairman and Vice-Chairman of the Council). The scheme was amended at the Full Council meeting on 7 July 2021 so that decisions could be made by the Council Manager, in consultation with the Chair of the relevant Committee and the Chairman of the Council.
